## **Directions on how to make money sliders:**

1. Cut out the horizontal strips of dimes, nickels, and pennies. Paste them onto construction paper or oaktag.
2. Make slits on the top and the bottom of the boxes  $\rightarrow \square \leftarrow$  so numbers slips can slide through.
3. Cut out the number slides. You may have to trim them to fit the boxes  $\square$ .
4. Slide a strip into a box. Tape the two ends of the strips together if you like.
5. Now you have a money slider.
