- An apostrophe (') is used to show that someone owns something.
- When there is one owner, use 's'.  
*The prince's golden baseball is kept in a fancy case.*
- When there is more than one owner, usually use s'.  
*The five royal dogs' golden bones were kept in a bowl.*
